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Question A is an example of the type of questions that you have to create:

QUESTION A

"Memory does not work like a videotape, it is better defined like a reconstructive processes".

The previous sentence is an example of:

1. Metacognitive monitoring
2. Metacognitive knowledge
3. Metacognitive control
4. Metacognitive appraisal

As you can see, to answer correctly Question A you should understand and differentiate the 3 types of components of metacognition.

Literal questions from the information of the handouts, like Question B, are NOT accepted.

QUESTION B

Which are the three components of metacognition?

1. Metacognitive knowledge, metacognitve monitoring and metacognitive control
2. Meta-awareness, meta-learning and metamemory
3. Metacognitive knowledge, metacognitive retrieval and metacognitive strategy
4. Metacognitive encoding, metacognitive storage, and metacognitive retrieval

This kind of questions only measure your recognition and not your comprehension and understanding of the material.
